White shark

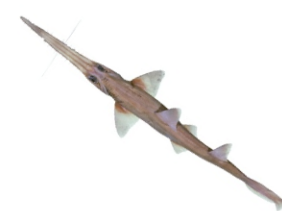
Carcharodon carcharias
